Position Summary

The Peer Recovery Specialist (PRS) supports students and community members in recovery or seeking recovery from substance use disorders through outreach, education, and peer-led support. This role helps foster recovery-friendly environments across Bluefield State University and Concord University campuses and surrounding communities.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

- Facilitate group and individual recovery-oriented interventions.
- Conduct outreach and early intervention with individuals in early stages of change.
- Plan, promote, and host recovery-related trainings and events.
- Deliver public presentations to combat stigma around substance use and recovery.
- Assist individuals in crisis involving social, emotional, or health challenges.
- Collaborate with college staff to build student recovery support systems.
- Connect students with community treatment and support resources.
- Serve as liaison among students, campuses, and service organizations.
- Collect recovery capital assessments and develop recovery plans.
- Complete required reports, paperwork, and participate in meetings.
- Represent the program and universities positively and ethically.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- High school diploma or GED required; college experience preferred.
- Current PRSS SUD credential required; supervision experience a plus.
- Knowledge of substance use disorders, evidence-based practices, and recovery support.
- Valid driver's license and reliable transportation required.
- Active involvement in personal recovery for a minimum of two years.
- No recent legal involvement or intensive behavioral health treatment (past six months).
- Pass criminal background check, WV CARES, and drug screening.
- Basic computer skills required.

Additional Information

This position includes a six-month probationary period. The successful candidate may mentor student workers and collaborate across campuses to enhance recovery support and reduce stigma.
